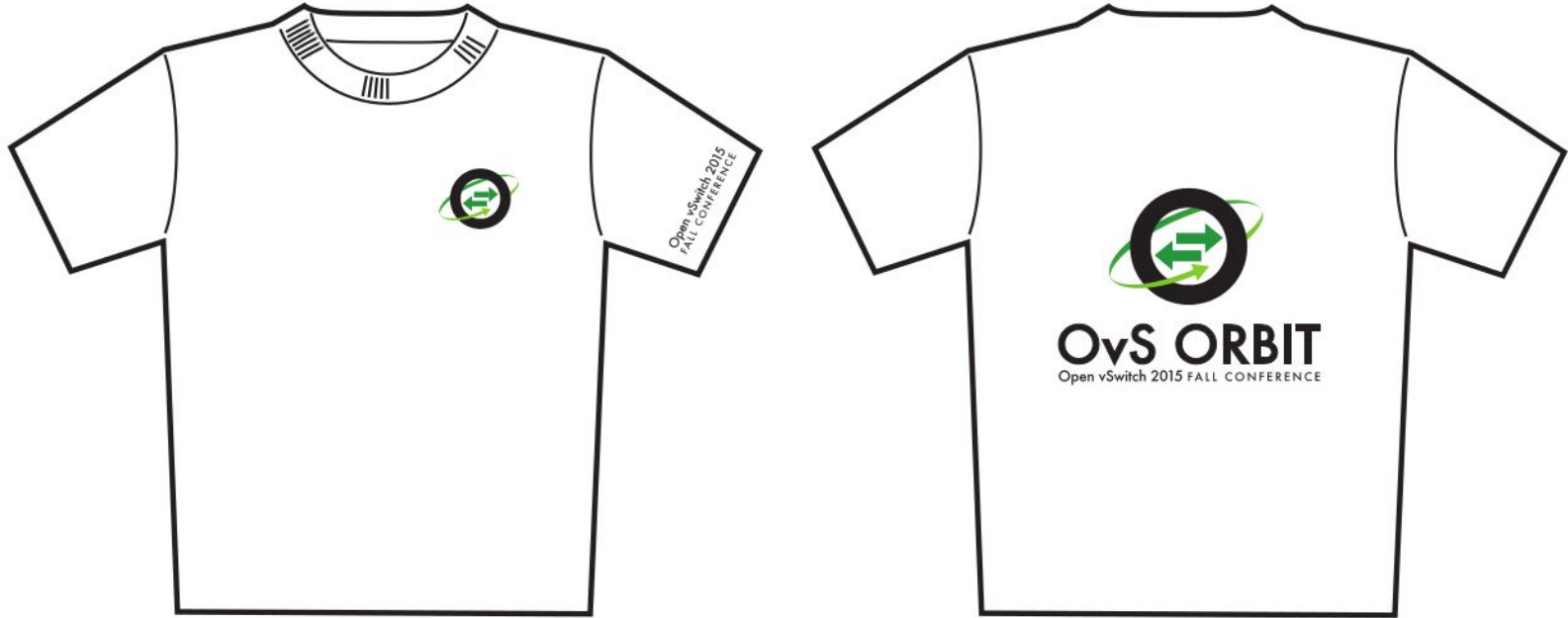
History

- Open vSwitch Hackathon 2013, Sept. 6-7, in IRC and email
 - ~20 participants
- Open vSwitch Hackathon 2014, March 26-27, at Cisco in San Jose
 - ~50 attendees each day
 - Most attendees were not hackers so we organized impromptu talks.
- Open vSwitch Fall Conference 2014, Nov. 17-18, at VMware in Palo Alto
 - 200 registered attendees + 100 on waitlist
 - 23 talks (30 minutes each)
- Open vSwitch Fall Conference 2015, Nov. 16-17, in San Jose
 - 300 registered attendees + 150 on waitlist
 - 2 keynotes
 - 27 of 36 talk proposals accepted (25 minutes each)
 - At PC request, 4 pairs of related talks were merged, hence 23 slots for talks
 - 7 lightning talks (5 minutes each)
